At Alkira Secondary College, we offer Instrumental Music Lessons for a range of instruments and have many ensembles for students to perform with including the Junior and Senior Bands, Junior and Senior Drum Ensembles and The Choir. Music students get the opportunity to perform solo or with ensembles at End of Term Concert Nights, Lunchtime Performances, Battle of the Bands, School Assemblies and at local primary schools.

Instrumental music lessons are currently available for the following instruments:

<i>Voice (singing)</i>	<i>Guitar: Electric or Acoustic</i>	<i>Violin</i>
<i>Keyboard/Piano</i>	<i>Drum Kit</i>	<i>Bass Guitar</i>

If your child is interested in lessons on an instrument that we don't currently offer, please write the name of the instrument on the enrolment form below and if we get enough interest we will endeavour to find an instructor.

- **Individual lessons: \$110 per term (\$440 per year)***
- **This averages out to \$11 per lesson for 40 lessons across the school year***
- **Lessons on a second instrument: \$90 per term**
- A rotating timetable ensures that there will be minimal disruption to a student's classroom subjects. Students are expected to remain up to date with all class work.
- Lessons are 30 minutes conducted by professional instructors and held during regular timetabled classes.
- Attendance at music lessons is the responsibility of the student.
- Students are expected to participate in band or ensemble rehearsals and school performances throughout the year.

*Year 12 students do not attend timetabled classes or music lessons during Term 4 of their final year. Annual fee for Year 12 students is \$330

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSONS - TERMS & CONDITIONS

To ensure that our program runs smoothly each week, we require students, parents & guardians to adhere to the policies outlined below. Please retain this form for your reference.

- Students must have **uninterrupted access** to an instrument at home, throughout the year.
- Students are responsible for attending lessons on time. They must check Compass each morning and we encourage students to copy lesson dates and times into a diary. A master timetable will be on the notice board in the red building next to the music rooms.
- Students are required to practise set work for 30 minutes per day, at least five times per week.
- Lesson fees must be paid as indicated on the enrolment form.
- If a student is going to be absent from any lesson, whether ill, on holiday or a school excursion or incursion, notification must be sent to imusic@alkirasecondarycollege.com.au or Parental Approval completed on Compass **by 8.30am on the morning of the lesson**. Failure to notify the **Instrumental Music Department** will result in forfeiture of the lesson. If notification is made correctly, a catch-up lesson will be arranged, often in the last few weeks of term or the following term.
- **If your child forgets to attend a lesson, that lesson will be forfeited.**
- Students undertake Instrumental Music study for the entire year. If, under extraordinary circumstances, a student has to withdraw from lessons, written notification from the parent/guardian **must be received five weeks before the beginning of the next term** and be addressed as follows:
